

# Regional Girls COY - Class 1A - 2021

## Keith Mills (Timothy Christian)

Timothy Christian had its best tennis season in school history in 2021. The Trojans won their third sectional in school history, qualified six non-seniors for state, and finished tied for 3<sup>rd</sup> at the state meet, earning the school's first ever tennis trophy. Crystina Lee finished in the top 8 in singles, while the duo of Clarissa Chen and Jane Carter earned a top 12 finish in doubles.

## Kathy Houpt (Danville)

Danville won its 20<sup>th</sup> sectional title since 1985 but its first in eight years. Kathy Houpt's Vikings qualified six non-seniors for the state meet and finished 5<sup>th</sup>. Lexi Ellis finished in the top 12 in the singles draw, and the doubles team of Josie Hotsinpiller and Ava Towne also earned all-state status by finishing in the top 16.

## Gerard Sullivan (Fenwick)

Fenwick won its first sectional title in four years and earned the school's first tennis trophy in history, finishing in a tie for 3<sup>rd</sup> at the state meet. The Friars will return all five state qualifiers next year. Trinity Hardin and Megan Trifilio finished 6<sup>th</sup> in doubles, while teammates Rachel Abraham and Maeve Paris finished in the top 12. Kate Trifilio was top 16 in singles.

## Daniel Pieplow (Flora)

Flora won a sectional crown for the first time in five years and finished 16<sup>th</sup> as a team at the state meet. Daniel Pieplow's team qualified four players for state, all of whom will return in 2022. Lanie Carder earned third team all-state, finishing in the top 24 in singles.
