Timothy Christian had its best tennis season in school history in 2021. The Trojans won their third sectional in school history, qualified six non-seniors for state, and finished tied for 3rd at the state meet, earning the school's first ever tennis trophy. Crystina Lee finished in the top 8 in singles, while the duo of Clarissa Chen and Jane Carter earned a top 12 finish in doubles.

<u>Kathy Houpt (Danville)</u>

Danville won its 20th sectional title since 1985 but its first in eight years. Kathy Houpt's Vikings qualified six non-seniors for the state meet and finished 5th. Lexi Ellis finished in the top 12 in the singles draw, and the doubles team of Josie Hotsinpiller and Ava Towne also earned all-state status by finishing in the top 16.

<u>Gerard Sullivan (Fenwick)</u>

Fenwick won its first sectional title in four years and earned the school's first tennis trophy in history, finishing in a tie for 3rd at the state meet. The Friars will return all five state qualifiers next year. Trinity Hardin and Megan Trifilio finished 6th in doubles, while teammates Rachel Abraham and Maeve Paris finished in the top 12. Kate Trifilio was top 16 in singles.

<u>Daniel Pieplow (Flora)</u>

Flora won a sectional crown for the first time in five years and finished 16^{th} as a team at the state meet. Daniel Pieplow's team qualified four players for state, all of whom will return in 2022. Lanie Carder earned third team all-state, finishing in the top 24 in singles.
