Lauren O'Donnell (Fremd)

Lauren's Vikings compiled a 14-2 dual record in 2017. Fremd won three Saturday invites and capped off their season winning the Mid-Suburban League and IHSA sectional titles. Fremd advanced all six players to state, where the Vikings finished 13th. Lauren's top doubles team, Kate Bodensteiner and Julia Smiarowska, finished in the top 12.

Kirby Morrison (St. Ignatius)

St. Ignatius finished 2nd in their IHSA sectional and 14th at the state meet. The Wolfpack, winners of three Saturday invites and their conference tournament during the year, finished with a dual record of 14-1 and qualified two singles players for the state tournament. Tyra Richardson finished in the top 8 and Ivvy Hicks earning all-state with a top 24 finish.

Bill Burt (Glenbard East)
