"Our team's accomplishments included an undefeated season in both duals and in invites, while often playing split squads. During the year, we've competed against teams from NY, KY, TN, WI, and IL. Our 2011 team championship was the second most in points and margin of victory in state history. Although I feel like 2010 required better coaching to win as underdogs, it certainly was a different challenge being favorites in 2011. I am proud of our team for being undefeated against the gauntlet and defending our team state championship. Like any other team in the state, some of our proudest moments were off the courts as we worked together to overcome difficulties in our scholastic, social, and family lives."
